General Description

As a Project Six19 volunteer you will play an important role in delivering messages to one of three target audiences: youth and young adults in church, youth in high schools, or parents. The role of a volunteer is to help promote and further the mission of Project Six19 and proactively help in delivering presentations in the community.

Volunteers Will:

1. Attend a two-day training seminar in the Fall and a two-day retreat in the Spring.
2. Willingness to learn *Life Up Close* and/or *Sex and God* presentations.
3. Participate in monthly volunteer meetings.
4. Make a one-year commitment to serving with Project Six19 and able to present a full presentation at least three times a year (four presentations each time), or as opportunities arise.
5. Pray regularly for your part in the ministry, and for the ministry as a whole.

Qualifications:

1. A commitment to Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.
2. Faithful attendance in a local church and participation in a Bible study.
3. Full agreement with the Project Six19 Statement of Faith and Statement of Commitment.
4. Exceptionally strong organization and interpersonal skills or willingness to learn and grow in these areas.
5. Demonstrated creativity, flexibility and comfort in working with diverse populations.
6. Dependable, stable and capable of following through on commitments.
7. Ability to respect confidentiality.
8. Gifted in one or more areas of need: prayer, speaking, researching, administration, etc.

What Will You Gain:

1. Learn to speak in front of several different audiences regardless of past experience.
2. Skills that will help in the work force either now or after college.
3. Knowledge of Scripture and insight into youth culture, sex, sexuality and relationships that go beyond anything learned in the classroom (practical experience).
